

Officials and employees of foreign diplomatic missions and international organizations accredited by the DFA





Only hotels or accommodation establishments with valid DOT Accreditation shall be allowed to accommodate guests and clients for **legitimate purposes under a state of public health emergency.**

PROHIBITED

- Gatherings outside of residences
- Gatherings at residences with any person outside of one's immediate household

ALLOWED

Gatherings that are essential for the provision of health services, government services, or humanitarian activities authorized by the appropriate government agency or instrumentality

SUSPENDED

Face-to-face or in-person classes at all levels

Law enforcement agencies shall recognize any of the following IDs :

- IATF IDs issued by the regulatory agencies with jurisdiction over permitted establishments or persons
- IBP ID for lawyers who will provide legal representation necessary to protect rights of persons under custodial investigation, to bail, and to counsel during inquest proceedings
- *bona fide* IDs issued by establishments allowed under ECQ
- if required by the LGU, local IDs for availing of essential goods and services

No other IDs or passes specifically exempting persons from community quarantine shall be required of workers of permitted establishments and/or offices without prejudice to requiring the presentation of other documents establishing the nature of their work.

- Movement of cargo/delivery vehicles as well as vehicles used by public utility companies shall be unhampered.
- Shuttle services of permitted establishments shall not be subject to an ID system but shall maintain compliance with minimum public health standards.




Private corporations are encouraged to process payrolls online.




In observance of the Lenten Season and to give way for the annual scheduled maintenance of these rail lines, the following schedule will be observed from March 30 to April 4, 2021:

50% Maximum Allowable Capacity for all PUVs*






