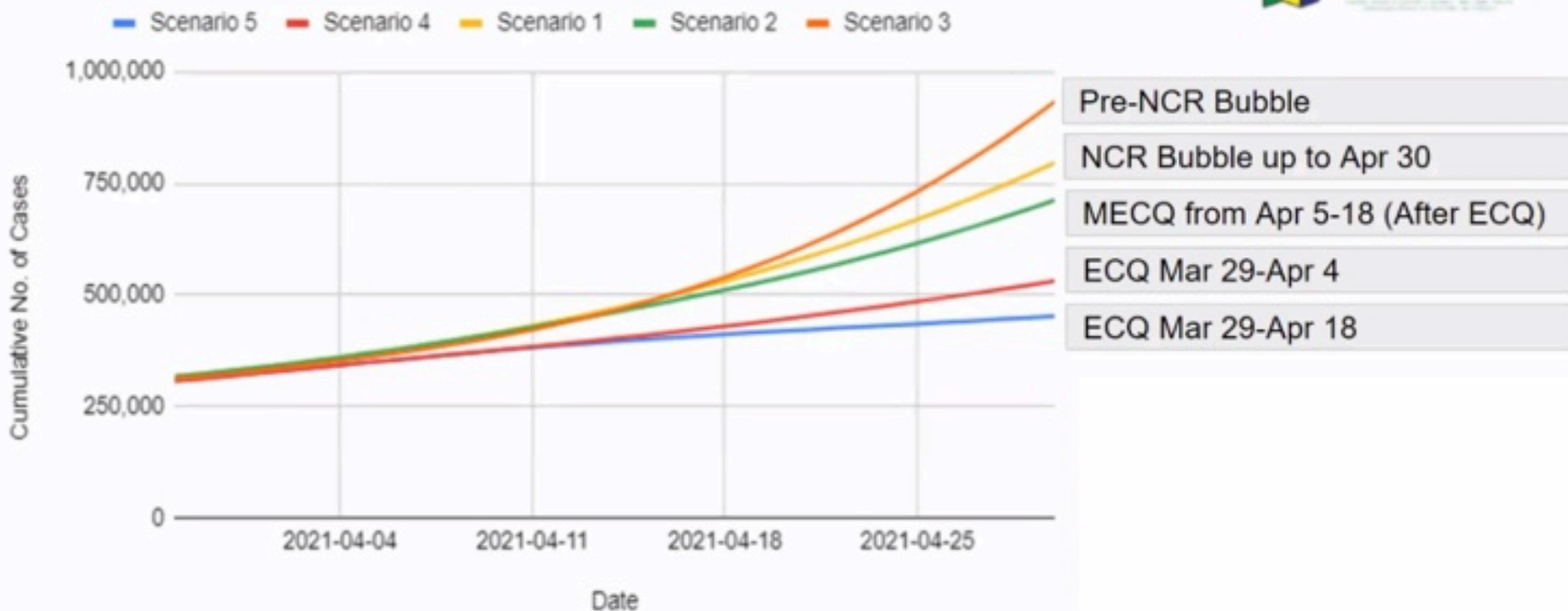

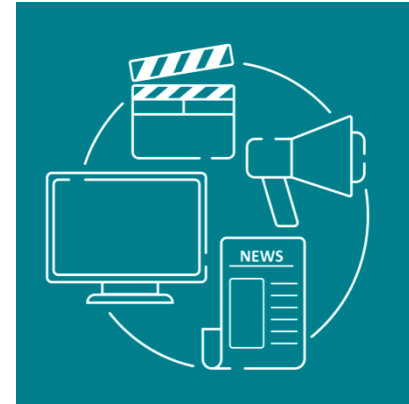

**Establishments, persons, or activities allowed to operate, work, or be undertaken**

<b>With full on-site capacity:</b>	
Public and private hospitals	Manufacturing related to food and other essential goods
Health, emergency and frontline services	Companies that manufacture and/or supply equipment/products necessary to perform construction/maintenance works
Manufacturers of medicines and vitamins, medical supplies, devices and equipment	Essential retail trade and service establishments
Industries involved in agriculture, forestry, and fishery and their workers	Food preparation establishments
Logistics service providers	Public and private financial service providers involved in the distribution of government grants and amelioration subsidies
Essential and priority construction projects – public or private	BPOs and export-oriented businesses (mining and quarrying activities)



**Max of 50% on-site capacity:**

Media establishments and their total permanent staff complement, inclusive of reporters and other field employees

# IATF Resolution No. 106-B



Only hotels or accommodation establishments with valid DOT Accreditation shall be allowed to accommodate guests and clients for **legitimate purposes under a state of public health emergency.**

# IATF Resolution No. 106-B

## PROHIBITED



- Gatherings outside of residences
- Gatherings at residences with any person outside of one's immediate household

## ALLOWED



Gatherings that are essential for the provision of health services, government services, or humanitarian activities authorized by the appropriate government agency or instrumentality

# IATF Resolution No. 106-B

**Law enforcement agencies shall recognize any of the following IDs :**

- IATF IDs issued by the regulatory agencies with jurisdiction over permitted establishments or persons
- IBP ID for lawyers who will provide legal representation necessary to protect rights of persons under custodial investigation, to bail, and to counsel during inquest proceedings
- *bona fide* IDs issued by establishments allowed under ECQ
- if required by the LGU, local IDs for availing of essential goods and services

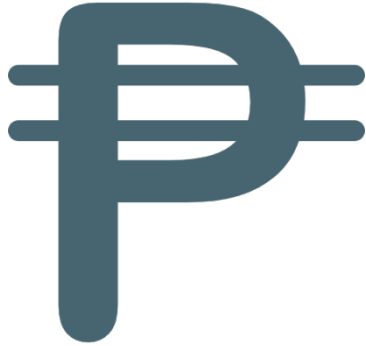
*No other IDs or passes specifically exempting persons from community quarantine shall be required of workers of permitted establishments and/or offices without prejudice to requiring the presentation of other documents establishing the nature of their work.*

## IATF Resolution No. 106-B

- Movement of cargo/delivery vehicles as well as vehicles used by public utility companies shall be unhampered.
  - Shuttle services of permitted establishments shall not be subject to an ID system but shall maintain compliance with minimum public health standards.

Private corporations are encouraged to process payrolls online.

Payroll managers, and such other employees required for the processing of payroll shall be allowed to travel to their respective offices during ECQ.

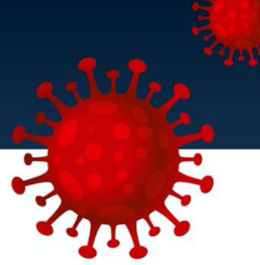

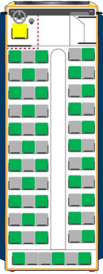

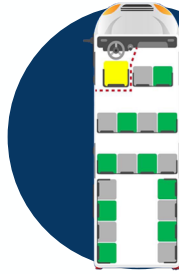
# CAPACITY OF PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLES



50% Maximum Allowable Capacity for all PUVs\*



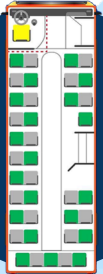
