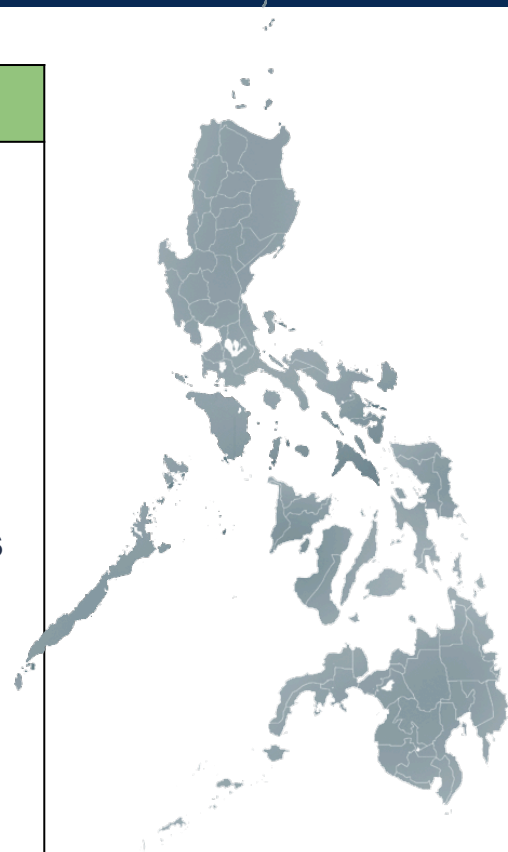

Recommendations of NEDA to further strengthen and improve the use of StaySafe.PH System through **automatic contact tracing using the Smart Messaging System**

IATF Resolution No. 109

To ensure interoperability and integration of all contact tracing applications integration in the StaySafe.PH System, the following are adopted:

Initial beta-testing, together with the proposed messaging, of the ***Smart Messaging System*** in **Pasig City due on May 1, 2021**, and **beta-testing in the consortium of Antipolo and cities of Pasig, Mandaluyong, Valenzuela due on May 1, 2021**, with access to COVID-19 Document Repository System (CDRS)

Immediate **completion of the transfer of ownership** to the DOH of the CDRS

Immediate **integration of the CDRS with the StaySafe.PH System** and other **local contact-tracing systems and applications**

DICT is directed to **lead in the national interoperability**



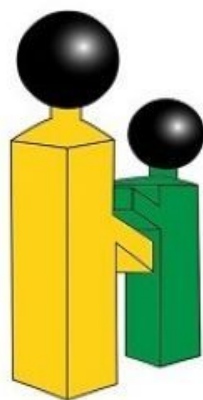
DOH is directed to **ensure integration of the StaySafe.PH System with the CDRS**
