STRICT HOME QUARANTINE IN ALL HOUSEHOLDS



ALLOWED

Limited to accessing essential goods/services
Work in permitted offices or establishments
Authorized Persons Outside of Residence (APOR)



AGE-BASED RESTRICTIONS

Required to remain in their residences at all times

Below 18 years old, over 65 years old, with immunodeficiency, comorbidity, or other health risks, and pregnant women

MECQ

Required to remain in their residences at all times

Below 18 years old, over 65 years old, with immunodeficiency, comorbidity, or other health risks, and pregnant women

LGUs may relax the minimum age range down 15 years old

(depending on the COVID-19 situation in their respective jurisdictions)

The road, rail, maritime, and aviation sectors of public transportation shall be **allowed to operate** at such capacity and protocols in accordance with guidelines issued by the DOTr.

The use of active transportation such as biking is encouraged.



SCHOOLS



SUSPENDEDECQ & MECQ AREAS

Face-to-face or in-person classes

The education sector shall operate in accordance with the guidelines of the CHED for higher education, TESDA for technical vocational education and training, DepEd for basic education.

- Gatherings outside of residences
- Gatherings at residences with any person outside of one's immediate household

ALLOWED



- Essential for the provision of health services, government services, or humanitarian activities
- Pastors, priests, rabbis, imams, religious
 ministers, assistants (religious services performed
 through online, necrological services, wakes, inurnment, and
 funerals, and they shall be allowed to move)
- Allowed to move: immediate family members to attend the wake or interment of the deceased

PROHIBITED



- Gatherings outside of residences
- Gatherings at residences with any person outside of one's immediate household

ALLOWED



- Religious gatherings 10% venue capacity
- LGU may increase up to 30%
- Allowed: gathering for necrological services, wakes, inurnment, funerals
- Allowed to move: immediate family members to attend the wake or interment of the deceased

All establishments, persons, or activities **not permitted** to operate, work, or be undertaken during ECQ **shall be allowed to operate at 50% on-site capacity**, while encouraging work-from-home and other flexible work arrangements, where applicable.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, and without prejudice to the authority of DTI to issue a **negative** list of industries which shall remain prohibited even in areas under MECQ.

MECQ

Uniform curfew hours may be imposed by LGUs, subject to the guidelines issued by the DILG.

Workers, cargo vehicles, public transportation, and operating hours of permitted establishments, however, shall not be restricted by such curfew.
