IATF Resolution No. 113-A

All areas shall continue to implement the following measures:

а	Improved implementation of engineering and administrative controls, especially ventilation standards and actions against crowdings and gatherings
b	Health promotion and strict enforcement of minimum public health standards, especially their uniform implementation in high-risk areas (healthcare settings, wet markets, supermarkets, government offices, workplaces, and at home, among others)
С	The implementation of localized community quarantine and the ramping up of the availability of identified quarantine facilities in priority/critical areas with community transmission (private and public establishments, with the concurrence of the RIATF)

IATF Resolution No. 113-A

All areas shall continue to implement the following measures:

Immediate facility-based isolation of all returning citizens, suspect, and probable cases, and the isolation of persons exhibiting symptoms and individuals awaiting their test results



Improved distribution of personal protective equipment, and waste management



Continuous health education on COVID-19 transmissions

IATF Resolution No. 113-A

All areas shall continue to implement the following measures:

Scaling up of local health systems capacity, especially for community isolation and critical care, including dedicated mechanical ventilators, and ICUs, isolation, and ward beds for COVID-19 cases

Submission of complete and accurate data through COVID-Kaya and the DOH DataCollect





Venue or Seating Capacity of 10%

Food preparation establishments (commissaries, restaurants, and eateries) may resume their indoor **dine-in services** in MECQ







Venue or Seating Capacity of 30%

Beauty salons, beauty parlors, barbershops, and nail spas may resume operations in MECQ

Shall only provide services that can accommodate the wearing of face masks at all times by patrons/clients and service providers

Beginning 01 May 2021, the foreign nationals allowed under previous IATF resolutions shall be allowed to enter the Philippines subject to the following conditions:

1	With valid and existing visa at the time of entry, except for those qualified under the Balikbayan program under RA No. 6768 or the Act Instituting the Balikbayan Program	
2	With pre-booked accommodation for at least 7 nights in an accredited quarantine hotel/facility	
3	Subject to COVID-19 testing at the quarantine hotel/facility on the 6th day from date of arrival	
4	Subject to the maximum capacity of inbound passengers at the port and date of entry	

Travel restrictions imposed by IATF Resolution No. 112 (s.2021) issued on 27 April 2021 shall continue to be in force.



All passengers coming from India or those with travel history to India within the last 14 days preceding arrival shall not be allowed to enter the Philippines starting 0001H of April 29, 2021, until May 14, 2021.



The Bureau of Immigration is directed to **formulate the necessary guidelines** to ensure smooth implementation of the foregoing.

The Commissioner of Immigration shall have the exclusive prerogative to decide on waiver or recall of exclusion orders for foreign nationals.
