Philippine Swimming Incorporated to host the Israeli National Swimming Team for their pre-Olympic training under a sports bubble format at the New Clark City Aquatics Center, Capas, Tarlac from 8 to 21 July 2021.

Provided, that the event shall strictly comply with the approved health and safety protocols.

IATF Resolution No. 123-C

Effective 01 July 2021, inbound international travel to any port of the Philippines of all individuals fully vaccinated in the Philippines regardless of travel history, and those vaccinated abroad who stayed exclusively in “**Green**” countries/jurisdictions in the past 14 days immediately preceding arrival, shall be governed by the following guidelines:

“Green” countries/jurisdictions
**are those classified by DOH as “Low Risk” countries/
jurisdictions based on disease incidence rate**

IATF Resolution No. 123-C

An individual shall be considered as having been fully vaccinated for COVID-19:

- i. More than or equal to 2 weeks after having received the second dose in a 2-dose series.**
 - i. More than or equal to 2 weeks after having received a single-dose vaccine.**
 - ii. The vaccines administered to the individual are included in any of the following:**
 - 1. EUA List or Compassionate Special Permit issued by the Philippine FDA**
 - 2. Emergency Use Listing of WHO**

**Fully vaccinated individuals shall carry the following
as proof of their vaccination status:**

- Those fully vaccinated in PH **must carry their vaccination card** which should be verified prior to their departure by a certification issued through the **Certificate of Vaccination Record Portal of DICT or the City Health Officer of the LGU** which administered the full vaccination; or

Fully vaccinated individuals shall carry the following as proof of their vaccination status:

- Those fully vaccinated in countries/jurisdictions outside PH **must carry their official documentation of full vaccination validated through the POLO**, or present their International Certificate of Vaccination, whichever is applicable.
 - The aforementioned documents **must be presented to the dedicated BOQ** representative for re-verification at the Department of Transportation One-Stop-Shop (OSS) upon arrival in the Philippines

**Required to undergo a 7-day facility-based quarantine upon arrival,
with the date of arrival being the first day**

All arriving individuals fully vaccinated in PH regardless of travel history, and **those vaccinated abroad** who stayed exclusively in “**Green**” countries/jurisdictions in the past 14 days immediately preceding arrival



The BOQ shall ensure **strict symptom monitoring** while in the facility quarantine for 7 days.

The individual is enjoined to monitor themselves for the next 7 days for any symptoms.

IATF Resolution No. 123-C

All arriving individuals qualified for a 7-day facility-based quarantine shall undergo **RT-PCR testing on the 5th day** of facility-based quarantine with day 1 being the date of arrival.

The 5th day testing requirement shall be subject to review after 30 days from implementation.

Should the RT-PCR test yield a negative result , the individual shall complete the 7-day facility-based quarantine	If found positive , he/she shall follow the prescribed isolation protocols

Upon completion of the 7-day facility-based quarantine, the **BOQ shall issue a Quarantine Certificate** indicating therein the individual's vaccination status.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 140

ADOPTING THE NATIONAL EMPLOYMENT RECOVERY STRATEGY (NERS) 2021-2022 AND REINFORCING JOB-GENERATING PROGRAMS THROUGH THE NERS TASK FORCE

Section 1. National Employment Recovery Strategy 2021-2022. The National Employment Recovery Strategy (NERS) 2021-2022 is hereby adopted, and the *Trabaho, Negosyo, Kabuhayan* initiative shall be expanded, taking into consideration the changes in the labor market caused by the COVID-19 pandemic and the fast adoption of new technologies.

Section 2. Constitution of the NERS Task Force.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 141

ADOPTING AS A NATIONAL PRIORITY THE IMPLEMENTATION OF MEASURES TO ADDRESS THE ROOT CAUSES OF THE RISING NUMBER OF TEENAGE PREGNANCIES, AND MOBILIZING GOVERNMENT AGENCIES FOR THE PURPOSE

Section 2. Interventions for the Prevention of Adolescent Pregnancies.

Consistent with their respective mandates, subject to coordination of efforts through the HDPR Cabinet Cluster, all government agencies and instrumentalities shall identify and implement as far as practicable interventions related to the prevention of adolescent pregnancies, such as comprehensive sexuality education, education and employment opportunities for young people, and health promotion through media and communications. Agencies shall closely monitor the implementation of interventions in their regional and field offices and units.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 142

APPROVING THE MERGER OF THE LAND BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES (LBP) AND THE UNITED COCONUT PLANTERS BANK (UCPB), AND THE ACQUISITION BY THE LBP OF THE SPECIAL PREFERRED SHARES OF THE PHILIPPINE DEPOSIT INSURANCE CORPORATION (PDIC) IN THE UCPB
