

**Provided, that pastors, priests, rabbis, imams, or other religious ministers and the assistants of these religious congregations have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19. MPHS shall be strictly maintained.**

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The **DOH** shall identify the **Alert Level** of the pilot area.




This area shall **follow the protocols** consistent with the declared Alert Level.



For the duration of the pilot implementation, **classification of the pilot area shall be done weekly**, unless otherwise specified.

# General Guidelines – Alert Level System for COVID-19 Response in NCR

**Close contacts**, regardless of the vaccination status and possession of a negative COVID-19 test result, of probable and confirmed COVID-19 cases shall **undergo 14-day quarantine** in accordance with the isolation and quarantine protocols set by the DOH.



**LGUs** in pilot areas shall **submit on a daily basis** to their respective RIATF such data as determined by National Government Agencies

**MPHS shall be implemented at all times**





## **Principles of 3C's** **(Closed, Crowded, and Close Contact)**

strategy against COVID-19 to curb the further spread of infection

## GRANULAR LOCKDOWN

**Micro-level quarantine for areas identified as "critical zones"**  
by the LGU which may be declared regardless of Alert Level

*\*Granular lockdowns shall be for a period of **not less than 14 days***

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## MOVEMENT

Allowed to move within, into, and out of the area under granular lockdown

- **Health care workers and non-health personnel** working in hospitals, laboratories, and dialysis facilities
  - **Uniformed personnel tasked to enforce the granular lockdown**
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# General Guidelines – Alert Level System for COVID-19 Response

The following shall be allowed to enter and/or exit granular lockdown areas for specific purposes:

- 1 **OFWs bound for international travel, and those returning to their respective residences** after having completed facility-based quarantine upon arrival;

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  - 2 **Individuals whose home or residence are located within an area under granular lockdown** may enter the said area for the sole purpose of returning to their respective homes or residences but must thereafter remain therein for the duration of the granular lockdown;

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  - 3 **Individuals under exceptional circumstances** such as, but not limited to, those seeking urgent medical attention as validated by the municipal/city health officer; and

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  - 4 **Food and essential items that are intended for delivery** within an area under granular lockdown provided that they can only be unloaded at border collection points designated by the LGU.

“The findings of auditing that handles PS-DBM really pertained more to inventory management and not the overpricing. Kasi ang nangyari po, I think you were flashing the figures earlier, you had purchases of, for example, iyong face mask anywhere from 13 pesos to 27 pesos. And they procured quite a bit and I think someone mentioned earlier na hindi nga natuloy iyong ibang deliveries because of inventory and warehousing space ‘no. The problem was, hindi po na-dispose kasi a lot of these equipment right away so that noong dumating po iyong September and the prices went down, the regional offices and the hospitals ng DOH, ayaw nang bumili o kumuha from PS-DBM kasi mahal.”
