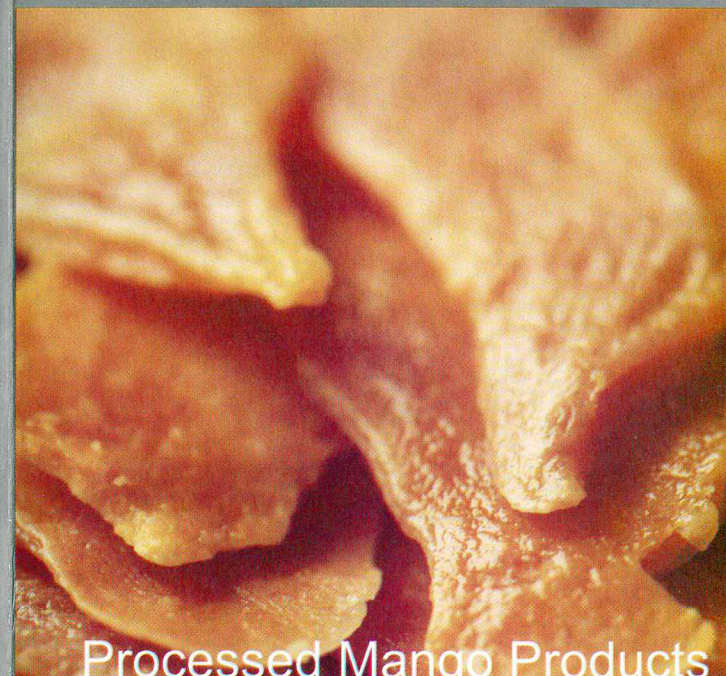

Also, the region was once home to a \$60 million pearl, the largest and most expensive pearl in the world. And although the Pearl of Allah (discovered May 7, 1934 off the coast of Palawan) resides outside the country, it has marked the beginning of a profitable pearl farming industry in Palawan.

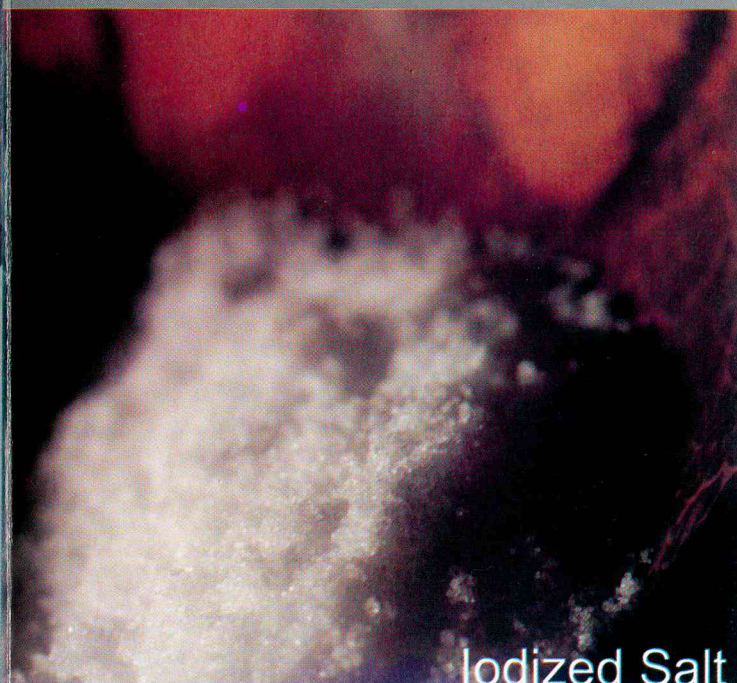
Another treasure that thrives in the province is its cashew nut production, along with the beautiful huntal of Marinduque, fresh and processed
