DEPARTMENT ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

SERIES OF 1987

SUBJECT: Standardization of Magnet Wires

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In accordance with the provisions of Executive Order No. 133, series of 1987, Sections 3 and 4(a) of R.A. No. 4109, the standardization of magnet wires is hereby promulgated for the information and guidance of all concerned.

1. NATIONAL STANDARD - The Philippine National Standard Specifications for Polyurethane Enameled Copper Wires Class 105, PNS 107:1987; Polyester Enameled Copper Wires Class 130, PNS 108:1987; Polyvinyl Formal Enameled Copper Wires Class 105, PNS 109:1987; Polyester Amide-Imide Enameled Copper Wires Class 180, PNS 110:1987; Oleo-Resinous Enameled Copper Wires Class 105, PNS 111:1987 and Methods of Tests for Enameled Copper Wires, PNS 106:1987, are hereby established as the national standards and shall prevail at all times.
2. COMPLIANCE - All manufacturers, distributors, traders, importers and sellers of magnet wires shall comply with all the requirements of said national standards.
3. IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES - The Bureau of Product Standards shall promulgate implementing guidelines for the said standards.
4. CERTIFICATION - A third party certification known as PS Certification Mark shall be obtained from the Bureau of Product Standards (BPS) by all manufacturers concerned. Importers of magnet wires shall acquire a commodity clearance from the BPS. All manufacturers and importers shall be qualified and listed by BPS which will be published for the information of the public.
5. EFFECTIVITY - The implementation of the standards shall take effect fifteen days after its publication in the Official Gazette or its announcement in any newspaper of general circulation.
