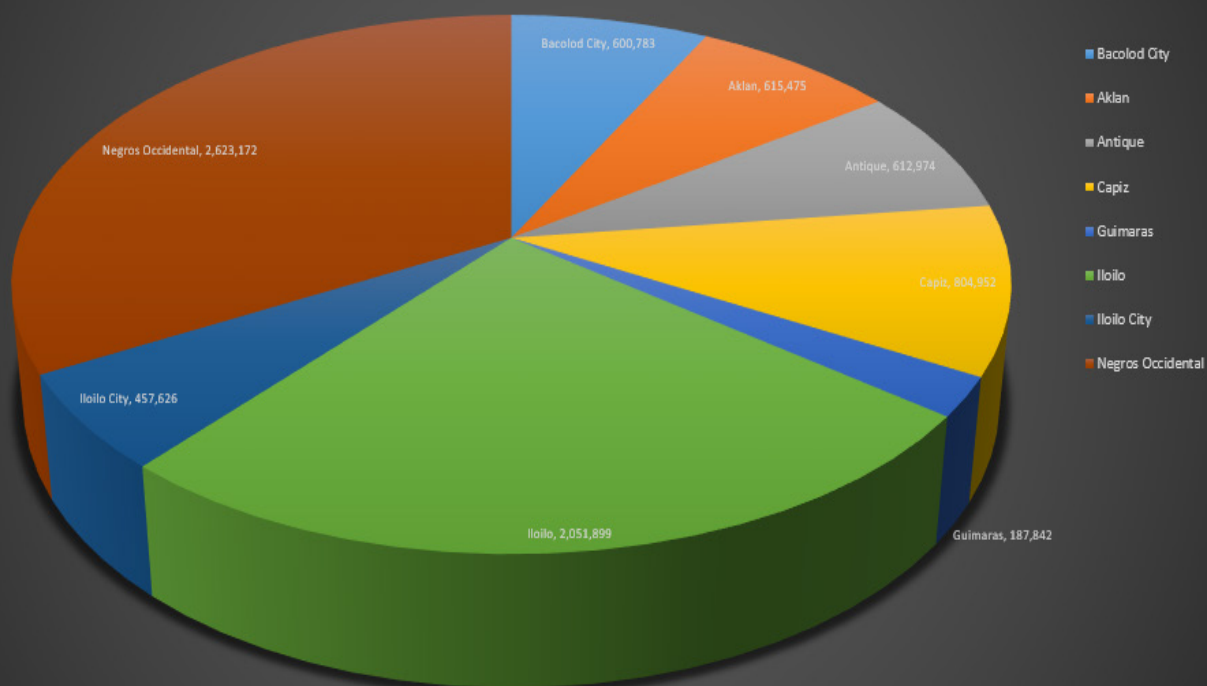

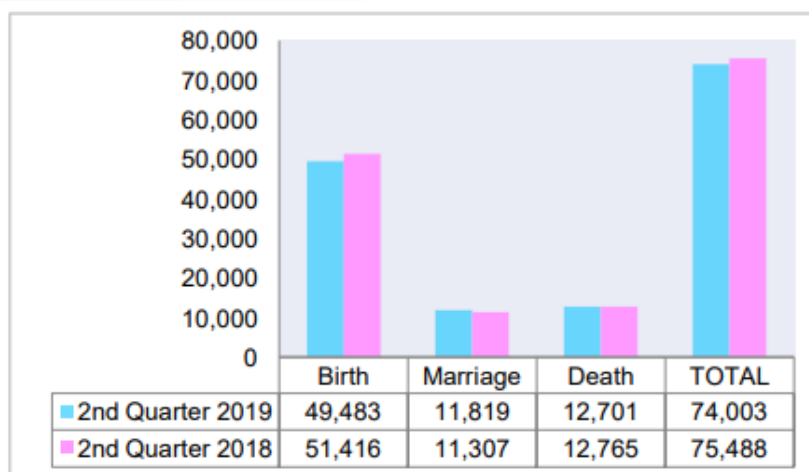

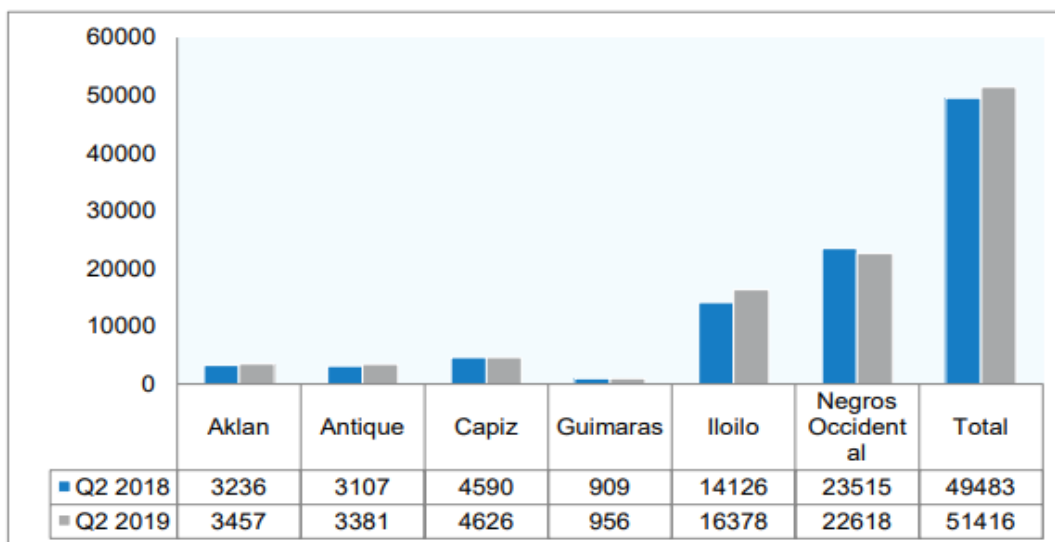

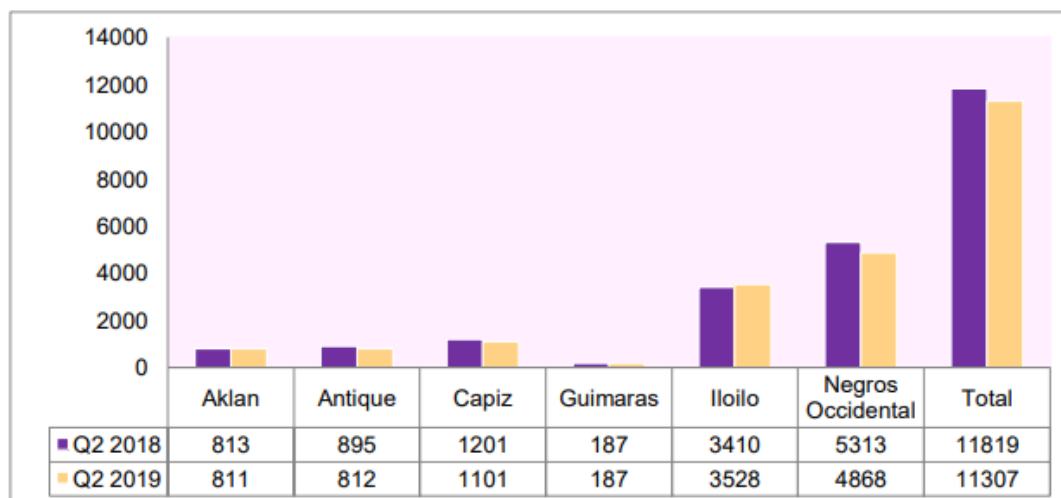
Total Number of Registered Births by Province: 2nd Quarter 2018-1st Quarter 2019

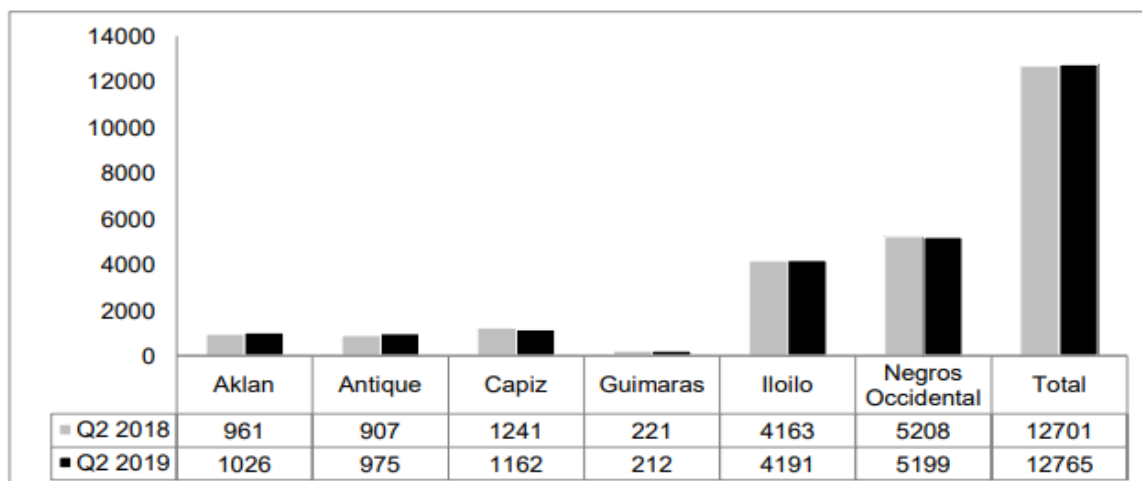
Total Number of Registered Marriages by Province: 2nd Quarter 2018 - 2nd Quarter 2019

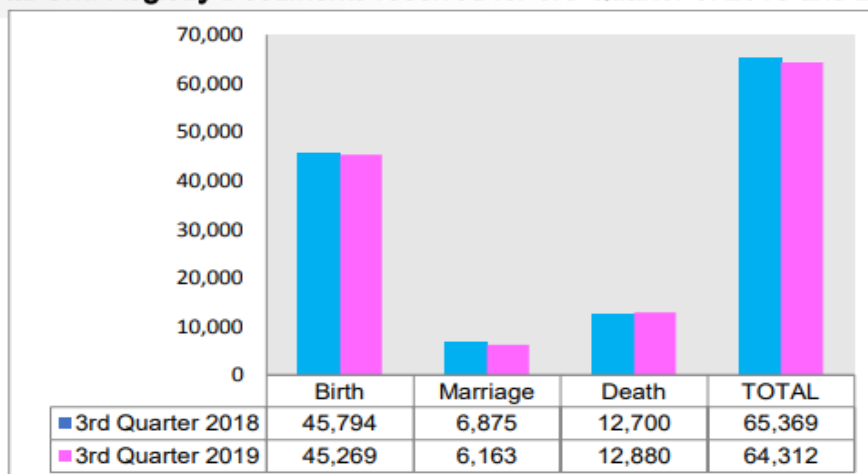

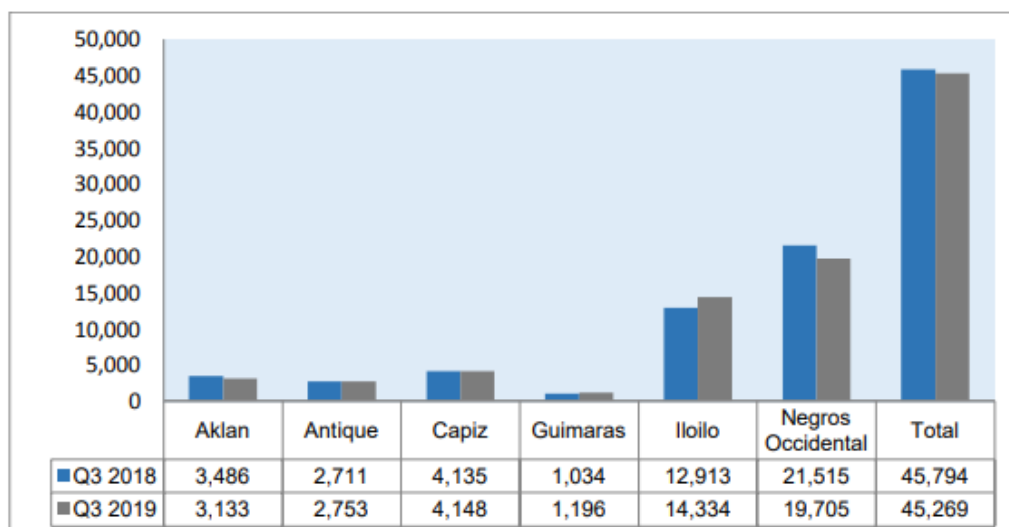
Total Civil Registry Documents received for 3rd Quarter of 2018 and 2019

Total Number of Registered Births by Province: 3rd Quarter of 2018 and 2019

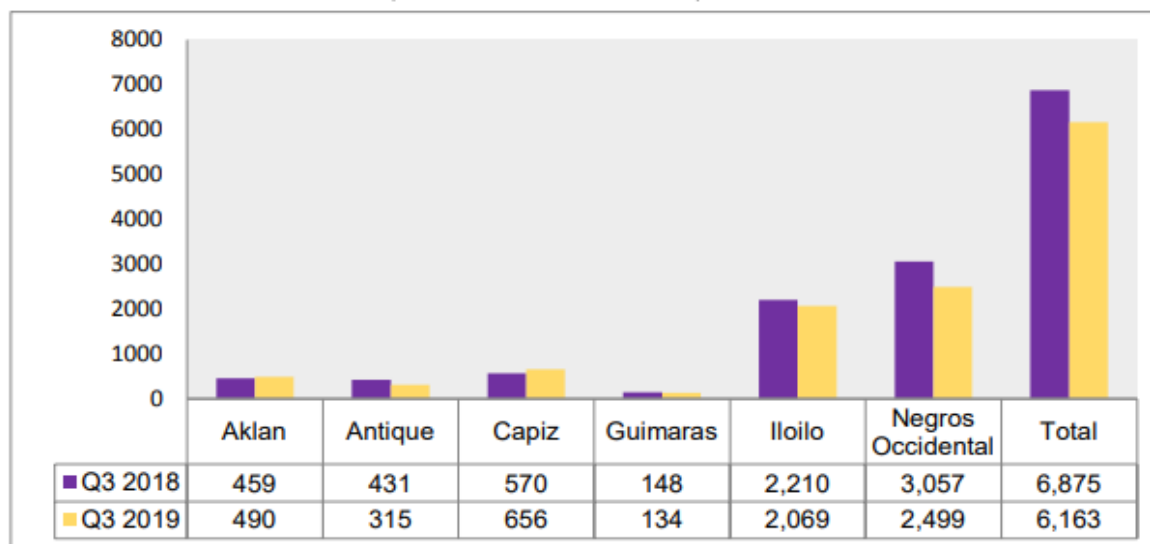

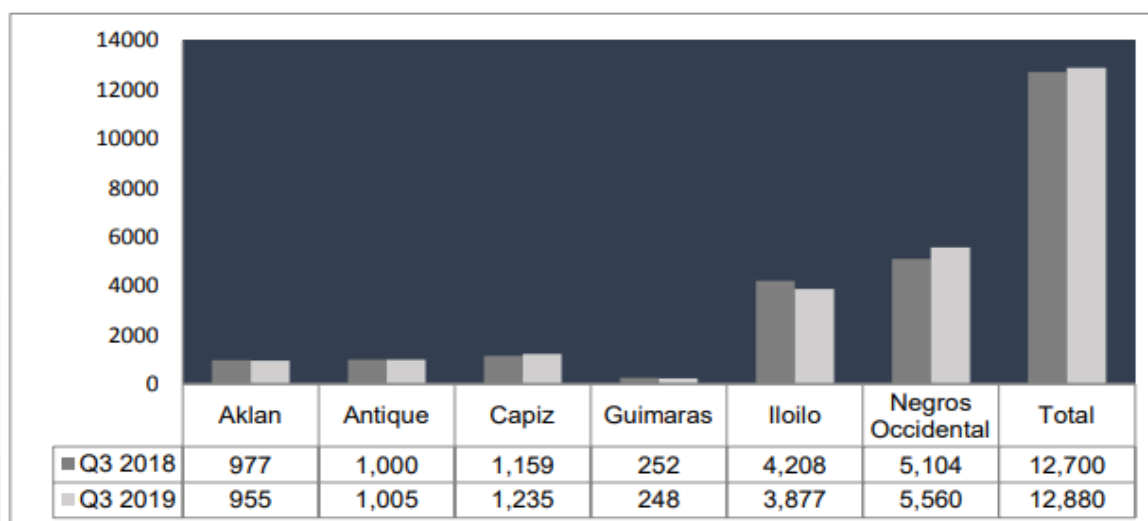

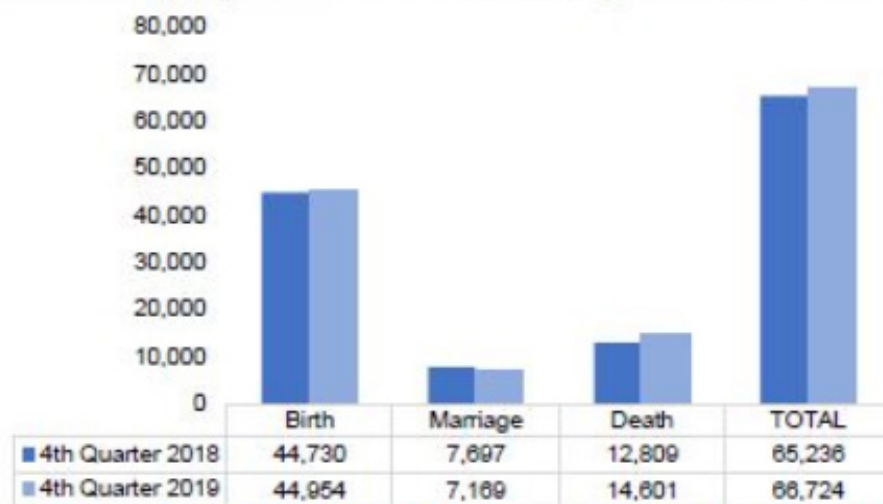

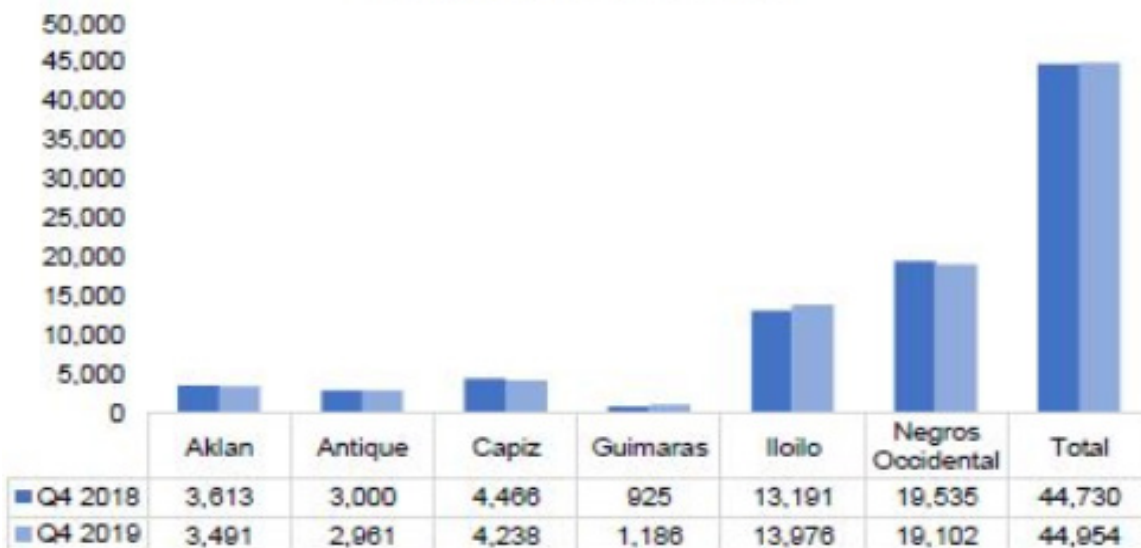
Figure 1. Total Civil Registry Documents Received During 4th Quarter of 2018 and 2019

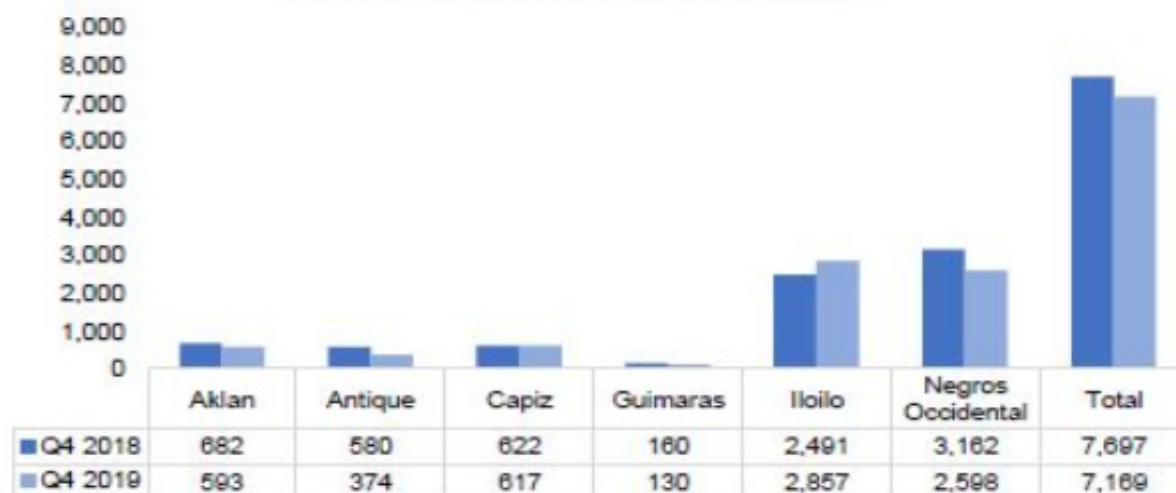
Figure 2. Total Number of Registered Births by Province, Western Visayas: 4th Quarter of 2018 and 2019

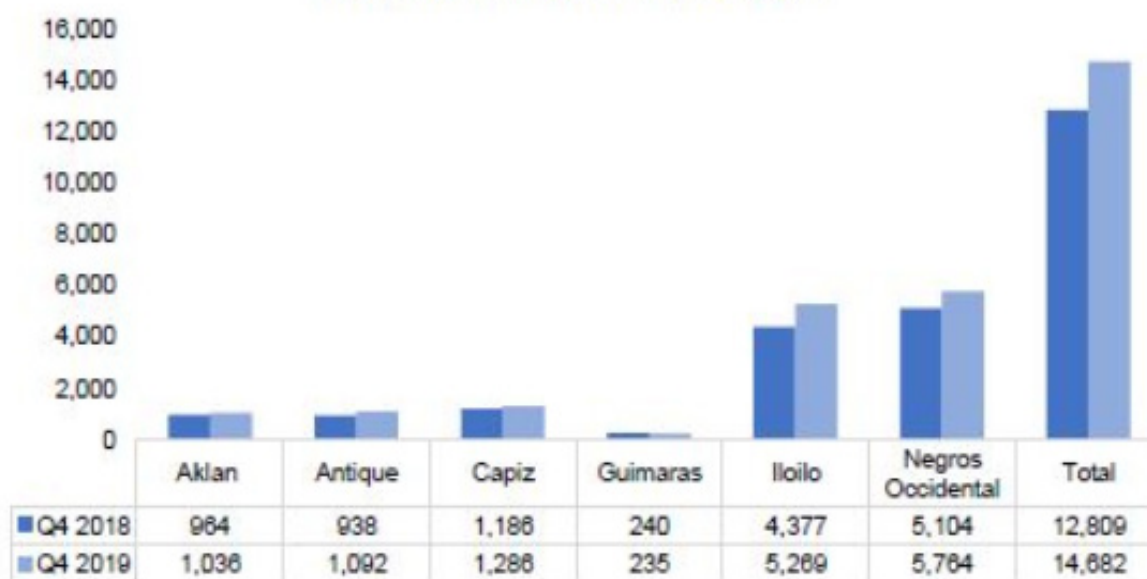
Figure 3. Total Number of Registered Marriages by Province, Western Visayas: 4th Quarter 2018 and 4th Quarter 2019

Figure 4. Total Number of Registered Deaths by Province, Western Visayas: 4th Quarter 2018 and 4th Quarter 2019

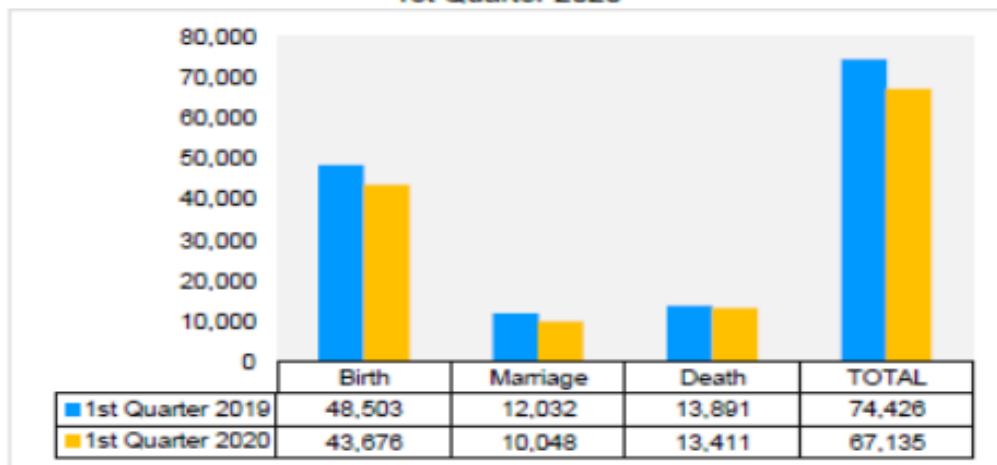

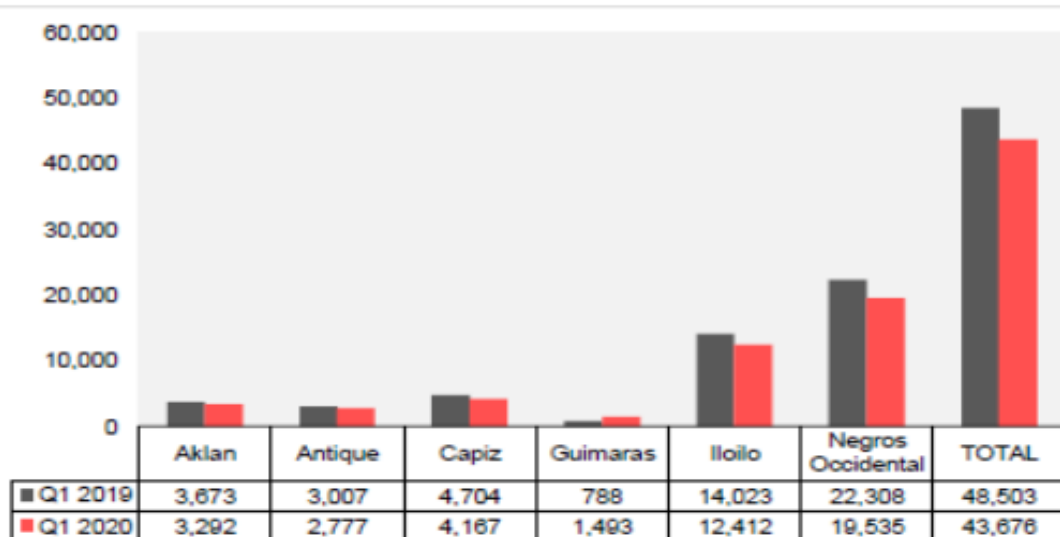
Figure I. Total Number of Civil Registry Documents received: 1st Quarter 2019 and 1st Quarter 2020

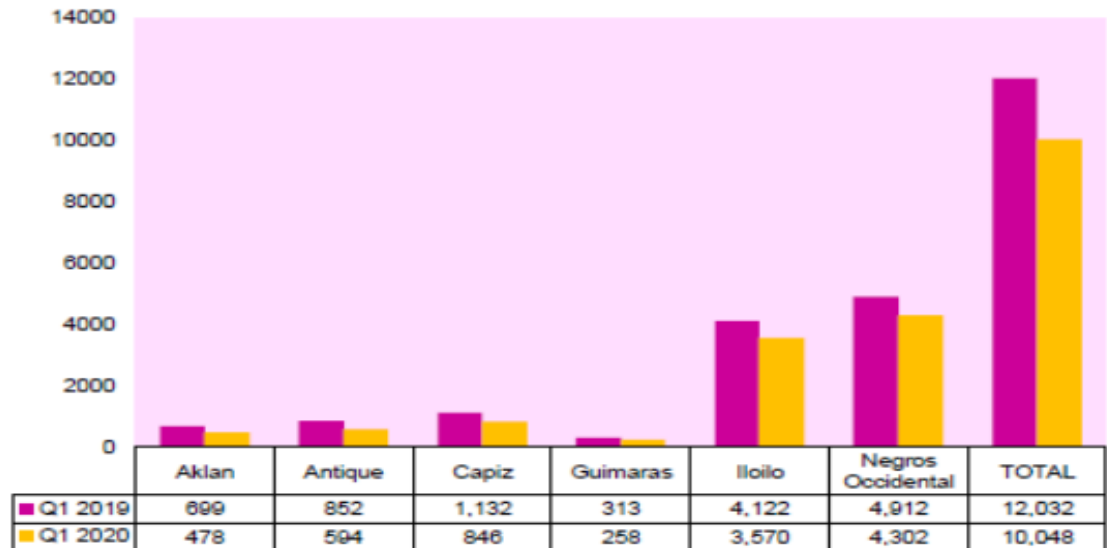
Figure II. Total Number of Registered Births by Province: 1st Quarter 2019 and 1st Quarter 2020

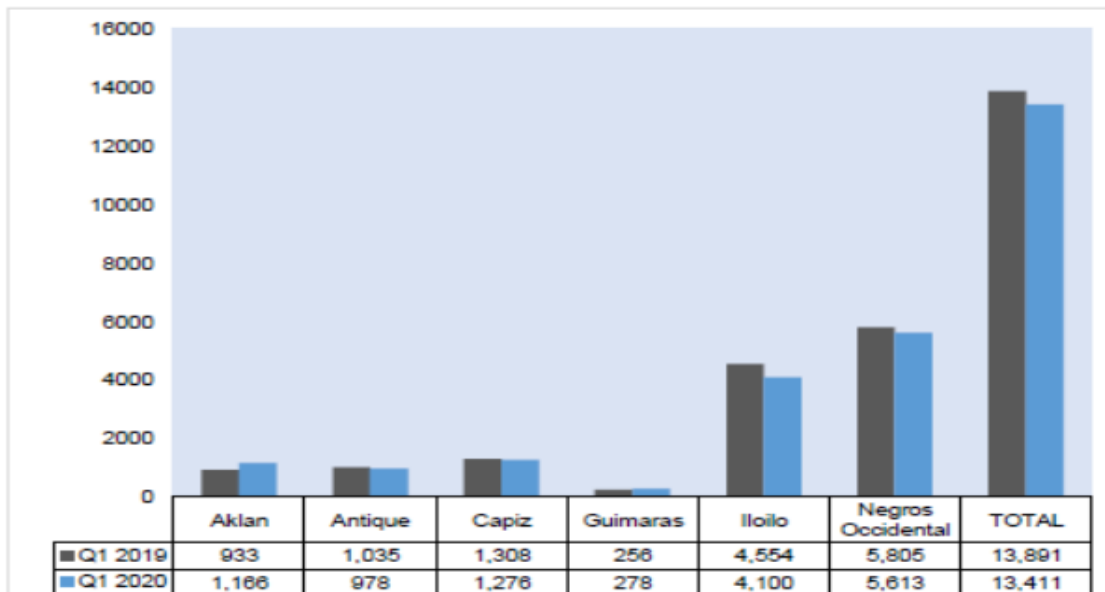
Figure III. Total Number of Registered Marriages by Province: 1st Quarter 2019 and 1st Quarter 2020

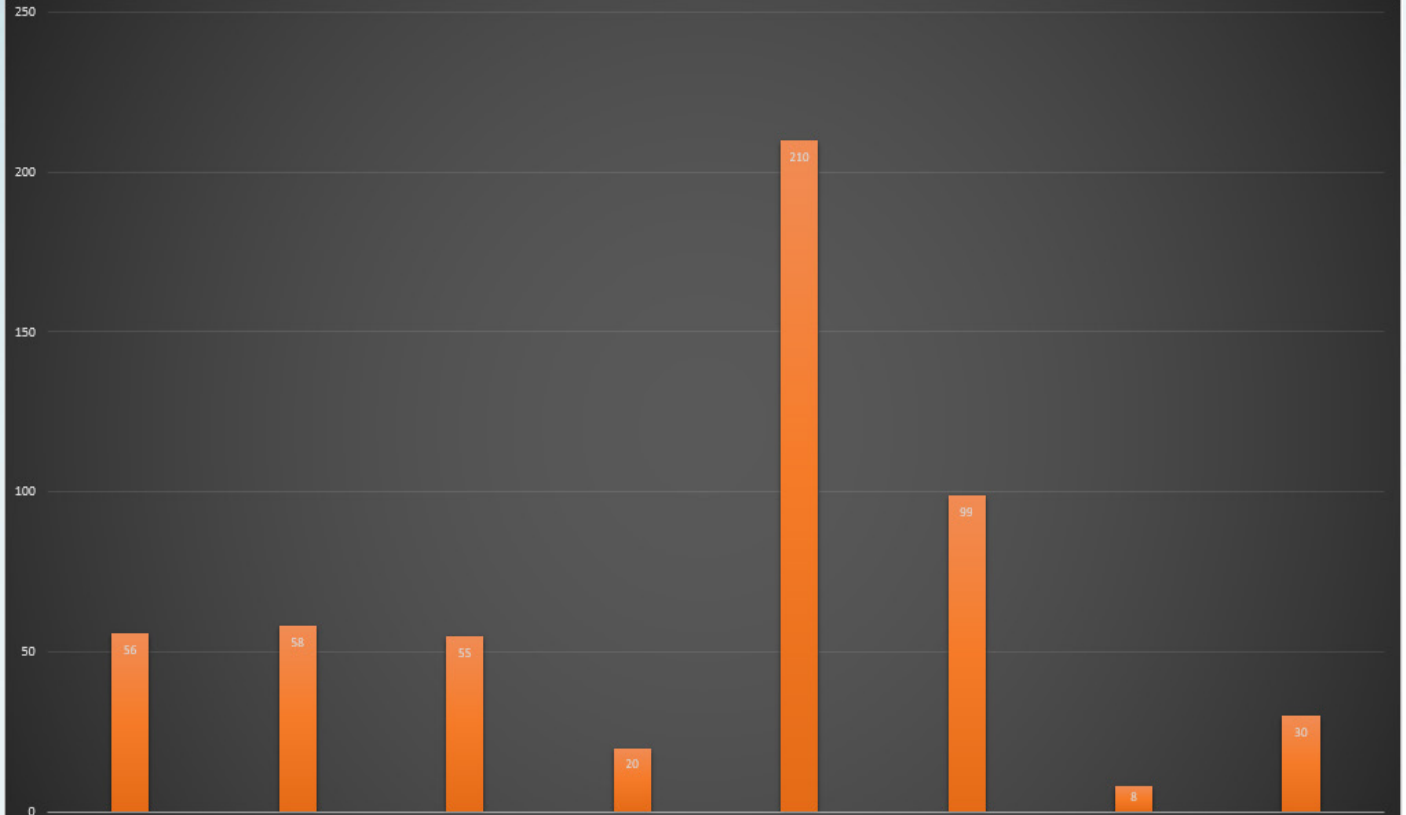

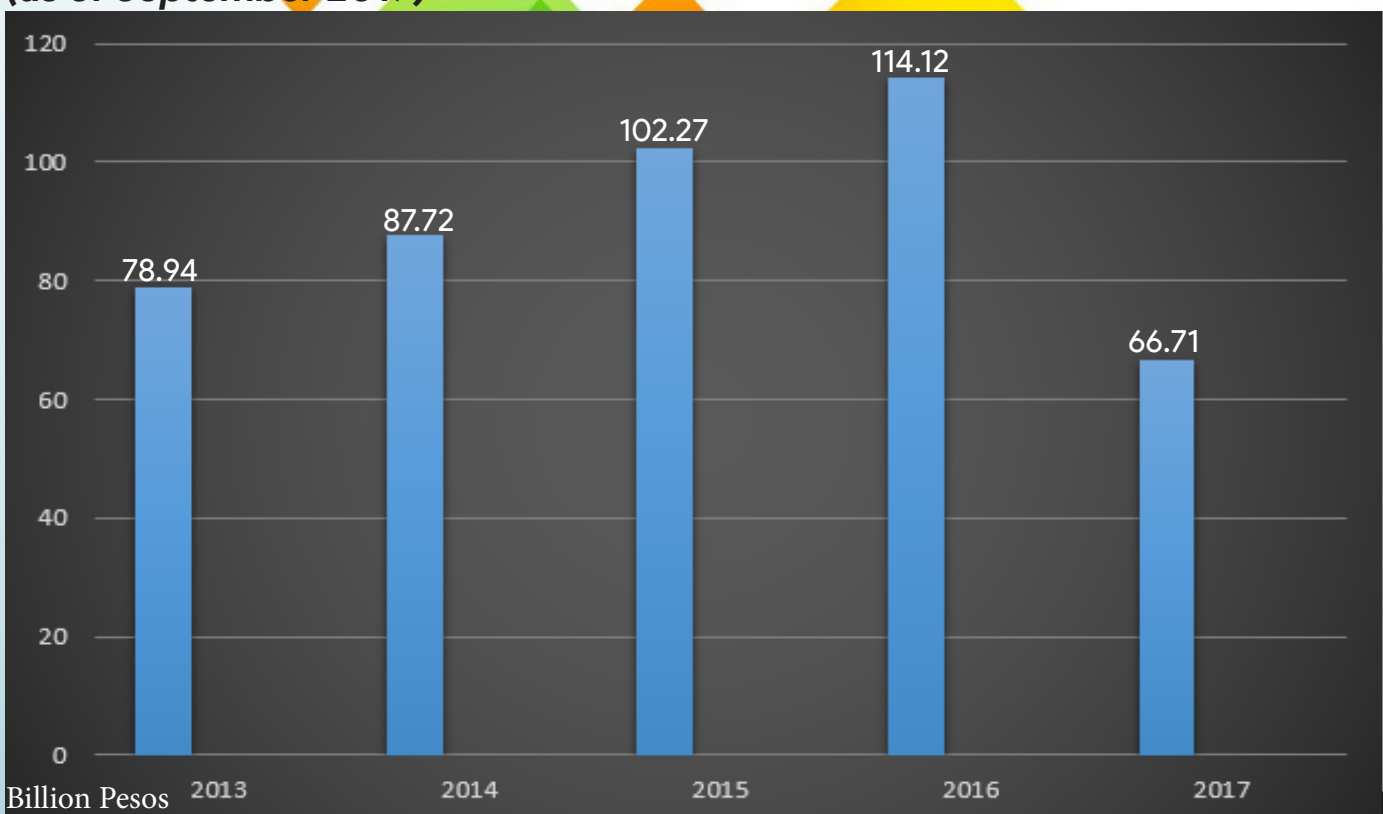

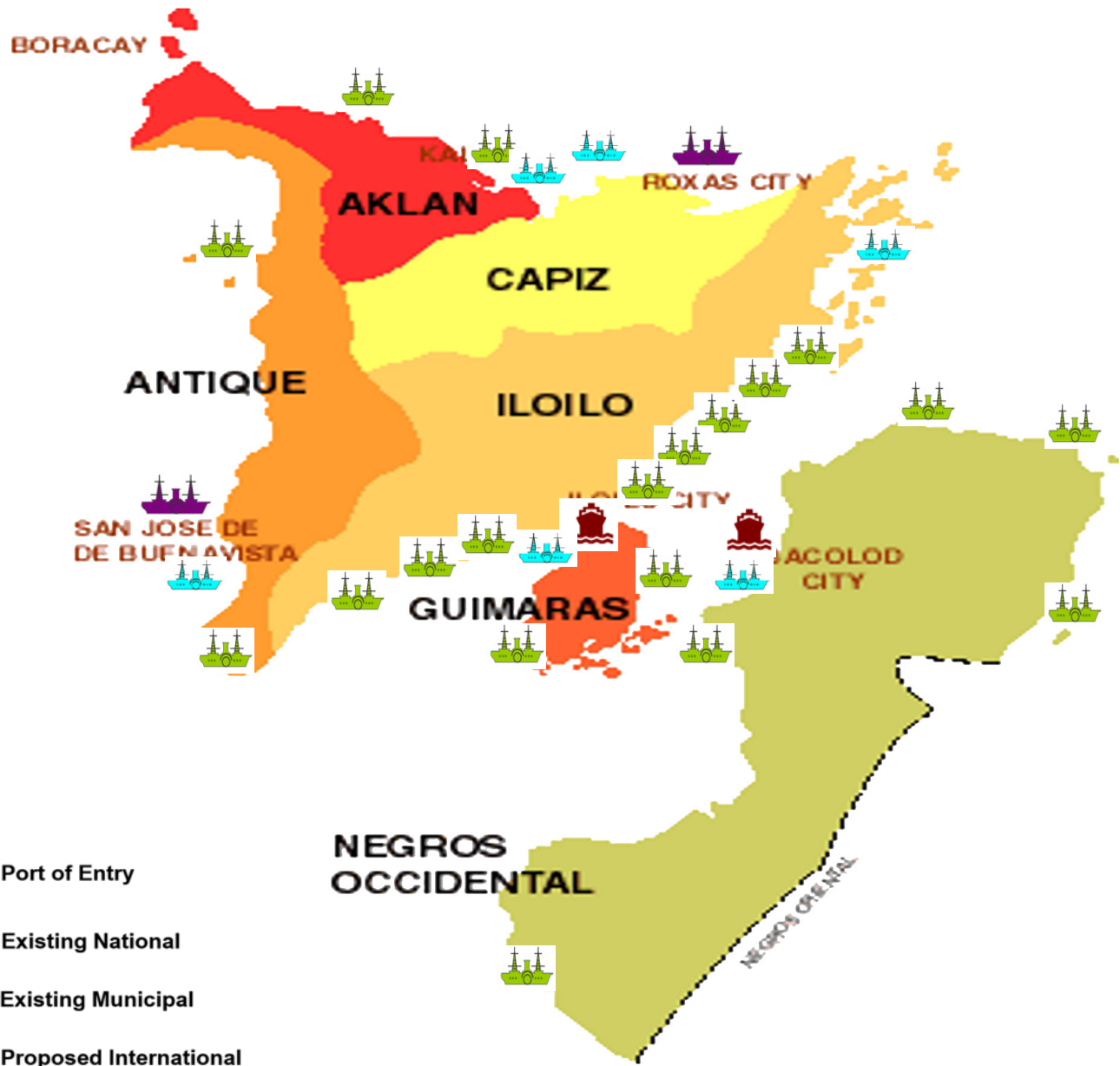
